Hundreds of plants were sold at the May 21 plant sale held at the pavilion at Freedom Park. The plant sale will also be held on Monday, May 30 beginning at 9 a.m. near the pavilion and continue during the Memorial Day activities held at the Park. Hosted by the volunteer gardeners of the Great River Road Visitor and Learning Center, the plant sale features annuals, perennials, vegetables, herbs and a selection of garden knickknacks.

Master Gardeners will be on hand to answer your gardening questions! Money raised from the plant sale will be used to beautify the Center's gardens, purchase needed tools, plant labels and more.

Plants for sale include hardy plants from the gardens of Master Gardeners, and perennials, annuals, vegetables and herbs grown by University of WI-River Falls floriculture classes- beautiful, healthy plants in packs of 4 and 6, as well as 3 and 4 inch pots. Prices for the 4 pack and 6 pack perennials and annuals are \$2, with 4" potted plants at \$3.
